On lifting of the Lockdown and resumption of normal class the school will charge the existing fees, as prescribed in the Fee Book, from that month. For students who have already paid full fees for the months from April 2020 to June 2020, the waiver amount for each paid month will be adjusted in the fees of the subsequent months when regular classes will resume.

We request all our parents to clear the reduced fees of their wards till June 2020 so that the school can smoothly conduct on-line classes regularly and upcoming online examinations. The First term exams are scheduled, and necessary arrangements require your co-operation on the outstanding fees, which is compulsorily required to be cleared so that your ward can participate in the exams.
